Administering the Summative ISAT Assessment in Spring 2022

Information for **Districts**



This spring, Idaho students will take the ISAT summative assessments, including the Idaho Alternate Assessment (IDAA) in English Language Arts/Literacy, Mathematics, and Science. The ISAT summative and Idaho Alternate Assessment (IDAA) window is open from 3/14/2022 through 5/13/2022.

Although the SDE expects all students to test in-person, districts may choose to administer the ISAT tests remotely. The IDAA cannot be administered remotely. When choosing to administer the test remotely, districts will need to participate in additional training and provide assurances of appropriate supports for students who are not able to test remotely due to technology limitations, accommodation needs, or other concerns.

When are the summative assessments scheduled?



The ISAT summative and Idaho Alternate Assessment (IDAA) window is open from 03/14/2022 through 05/13/2022. For paper-and-pencil tests, the window is 04/04/2022 through 05/06/2022.

Do the summative assessments need to be administered in-person?



Although the SDE expects all students to test in-person, districts may choose to administer the ISAT tests remotely. Remote administration is not available for the IDAA. Some accessibility features and accommodations (such as print on demand, word prediction, read-aloud, and a scribe) may necessitate that a student test in-person.

Do districts need to have all students test using the same mode of administration?



Districts and charter schools who need to administer remote testing can assess some students in-person and some students remotely. All students must have an opportunity to participate, which requires appropriate technology and accessibility. Districts using remote administration will still need to have a plan for assessing students for whom testing remotely is not supportable.
