



What to expect on the Idaho Alternate Assessment (IDAA) Spring 2020 Administration for ELA and Math



In Spring 2020, students are taking the IDAA in grades 3-8 and 10.



In the Spring 2020 administration, Idaho will deliver an online operational Computer Adaptive Test (CAT) for ELA and Math.



Paper fixed form test materials will be available for students with a paper testing accommodation on their IEPs and will consist only of printed answer choices.



The Spring 2020 administration will be administered with Human Voice Recording. A student's need for a familiar reader must be documented as an IEP accommodation.



Students for whom the Early Stopping Rule is applied will not participate in the entire test past the first 4 items.
