

What to expect on the Idaho Alternate Assessment (IDAA) Spring 2021 Administration for ELA, Math and Science



Students will take the IDAA in ELA and Math in grades 3-8 and 10 and the IDAA in Science in grades 5, 8 and 11.



The new IDAA in ELA and Math will be online operational Computer Adaptive Tests (CAT). Scores will be available in fall 2021.



The new IDAA in Science will be an online Independent Field Test. No scores will be available for this test.



The Spring 2021 administration will be administered with Human Voice Recording. A student's need for a familiar reader must be documented as an IEP accommodation.



Paper fixed form test materials for the IDAA in ELA and Math will be available for students with a paper testing accommodation on their IEPs and will consist only of printed answer choices. This option is not available for the IDAA in Science Independent Field Test.



Students for whom the Early Stopping Rule is applied will not participate in the entire test past the first 4 items.
